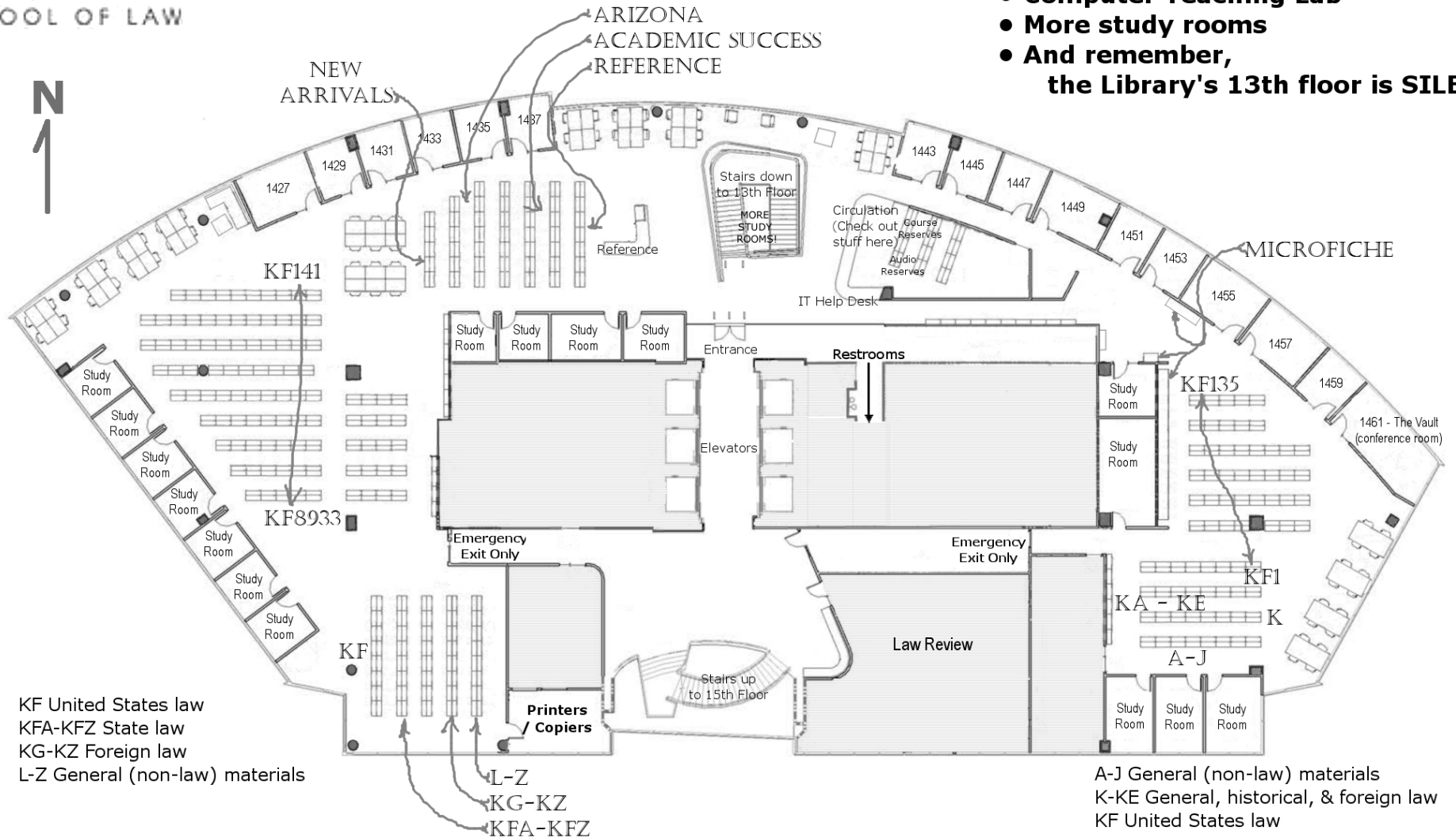


WHERE TO FIND YOUR BOOKS IN YOUR LAW LIBRARY

Items are shelved in Library of Congress call number order, beginning in the southeast corner running north and continuing in the northwest corner running south. Exceptions: Arizona materials, Academic Success, Reference, New Arrivals, Audio/Video, and Course Reserves. Call numbers can be found in our catalog.

Call Numbers

Our physical books, both print and microfiche, are arranged on the shelves (in the drawers for microfiche) in “call number” order. A call number is the alphanumeric sequence found on the spine label of each book. The system of call numbers we use was developed by the Library of Congress. Every book we own has a different call number, a sequence that is usually the same in every library in the U.S. that uses the Library of Congress system. If we determine that the Library of Congress call number would place a book in an inconvenient or confusing location, we assign it a local call number using the same pattern. For you, it makes no difference unless you are using another law library.

We assign call numbers to books for one simple reason. While you can find an online resource by tags, metadata, or full-text searching, a physical book can only be shelved in one place. Many books cover more than one subject. However, we must choose one subject under which to shelve the book. We record all the subjects covered by a book in its catalog record so you can find a book by subjects other than the one corresponding to its call number, but we shelve it by call number.

Call numbers beginning with “A” cover general works, “B” - philosophy, psychology, religion, “C” through “F” - history, “G” - geography, anthropology, “H” - other social sciences, *e.g.*, economics, “J” - political science. **Call numbers for all legal topics begin with “K”.** Call numbers beginning with “L” cover education, “M” - music, “N” - fine arts, “P” - language, literature, “Q” - science, “R” - medicine, “S” - agriculture, “T” - technology, “U” - military and “V” - naval science, “Z” - bibliography, library science, and general information resources.

When looking at call numbers, “K” comes before “KA”, which comes before “KAA”, which comes before “KB”, *etc.*

For your convenience, here is a cross-reference table from each legal subject to its “K” series call number. You will find books in each subject area in the general stacks on the east and west sides of the Library, with a few exceptions – books in our academic success, Arizona, audio/video, reference, and reserve collections (they are labeled as such) are located separately as shown on the map.
